Topics of Conservation and Recommendations Reported to the CSCD Board

- Recommended a course of action for violations of leaves and debris being blown into lakes and coves
- Price increase for boat stickers
- Recommended freeholders read and sign a “10-Point Awareness Questionnaire” before receiving new boat stickers
- New gas pumps were purchased for both marinas
- Purchased an AED machine for officer patrol car and budgeted one for beach in 2019
- Recommended new traffic lights be purchased and installed at both dams
- Budgeted for a new police patrol car for 2019
- Recommended the physical address be placed at beach and Cordry dam for emergencies
- Discussed a course of action to implement resolution 2015-10
 - o Disabling ballast/wake enhancing devices on boats
