

CORDRY SWEETWATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT
SEDIMENT REMOVAL PERMIT APPLICATION FORM
(ONLY FOR PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO DECEMBER 15 OF THE CURRENT YEAR)

This form is to be used by CSCD freeholders who intend to contract privately with the current CSCD dredging contractor to have sediment removed prior to December 15 of the current year from lakefront areas contiguous to their property on Sweetwater Lake. The work is to be solely for the purpose of removing sediment that has accumulated such that it reduces water depth, impairs recreational access and/or watercraft navigability, and/or impedes watercraft mooring in locations previously usable for those purposes.

Approval of any projects is contingent upon the availability of adequate dredge spoil disposal space.

Projects will be evaluated in the order in which they are received by the CSCD.

Any project approved by the CSCD pursuant to the information presented in this application may only be performed by the current CSCD dredging contractor using the "one-step" methods that will not require regulatory permission from either the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers or the Indiana Department of Environmental Management.

No work can be performed without first receiving explicit written approval from the CSCD.

Submittal of this form does not, in itself, constitute CSCD permission to perform the work. The application form must be reviewed by appropriate CSCD representatives and will serve as official approval only upon being properly signed by a CSCD-designated representative.

Owners of multiple adjacent properties may jointly contract with the current CSCD dredging contractor and submit a single application form.

Excavation or alteration of the shoreline will not be allowed.

No excavation into or beneath the original lake bottom will be allowed.

Sediment should be removed in such a manner as to create a smoothly tapered bottom contour terminating at the shoreline.

Applicant(s) and the current CSCD dredging contractor agree that all work performed in accordance with this application and its approval shall be solely at the applicant's(s') expense and that the CSCD is not a party to any contract between the applicant(s) and the current CSCD dredging contractor and will therefore have no financial responsibility for any of the work.

The permit applicant shall indemnify and hold the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District, its board of directors, employees, agents and assigns ("Indemnified Parties") harmless from any and all claims, demands, actions, damages, costs and charges, including reasonable attorney's fees, to which the Indemnified Parties may be subject to or which the Indemnified Parties may have to pay by reason of any injury to any person or property, or loss of life or property resulting from or in any way connected with the work authorized by this permit, including, but not limited to, the character, condition or use of the area in which the work is to be performed, or any means of ingress thereto or egress therefrom, and shall, at its own expense, assume the defense of such claims and actions for damages arising out of such injuries or losses which may be brought against the Indemnified Parties by any such entity, and shall pay any such judgments that may be rendered in such actions.

By signing and submitting this permit application, I am agreeing to all of the terms and conditions of all included pages of the permit application form and have read and understand all of its contents.
