1. Marina opening date this spring
 - a. Sweetwater and Cordry Marina will open for the season the week before Memorial Day (5-18 2019) and remain open until the second weekend in September (9-8-2019).
2. Seasonal Employees
 - a. Employees are set to be hired and trained for upcoming season.
3. Patrol Boat Cleaning
 - a. Discussed the possibility of a boat wash station at each ramp to prevent invasive plants and species from entering lakes and ways to monitor this.
