(Thus the need for a potential rate increase) Profit and Loss concerns are equipment, repairs, and operations. A bigger expense this month for software, which was expected, but impacted the bottom line.

Water Operator Report: IFA LCRR LSL Grant funding has been conditionally approved for a \$100,000 grant for lead service line inventory. Working for multiple bids to submit IFA for their requested documents. Working on 3 vendor reports to be included w/ rate study. Clarify bids / parts required for multiple maintenance projects including truck replacement projects for rate study. 46% loss reported for month of July. 450 ft replaced of service line YTD. Utilization of remaining SRF funds it is best utilized to purchase an asset for the utility.

A motion was made by T. Kuhn and seconded by D. Caudill w/ unanimous approval for the pursuit of utilizing SRF funds to reimburse the utility for a portion of the vac truck.

Old Business: Rate study and water line replacement cost projections is ongoing. Emergency Response Plan – new business for next month, as Tom K. has kept this document revised.

New Business: Discussed water status w/ building/septic violation on elm drive. Recommended unanimously consulting with IDEM prior to reinstating water.
