## I. Winter Update

a. Mr. Hawley reported that due to the new brine equipment and new winter event procedures, the District has so far saved an average of \$800 per winter event in 2019 when compared to 2018. This equates in a savings of \$11,000 so far in 2019.

# II. Paving Update

- a. Mr. Hawley is prepping the bid package to send to Milestone, E & B Paving, and Rieth-Riley for the 2019 Paving Plans. Roads included in the plans includes: Portion of Sweetwater Drive (Centerlake Rd to Duck Dr), Mallard Dr, Bottom 1/3 of Lion Dr, Leopard Dr, Grizzly Dr, Grizzly Ct, Badger Dr, Elm Dr, and Ebony Dr. Which/ how many of these roads are paved in 2019 will depend on the bid numbers.
- b. Mr. Hawley will also be submitting a bid package to re-stripe all lines on main roads.

### III. 2019 Winter Flood Update

a. Mr. Hawley reported minimal damage around the District from Feb. 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 floods. Most of the District's drainage improvements installed in the last 5 years did a great job of holding back and taking water. Hummingbird Drive still has drainage issues and Mr. Hawley is continuing to work with homeowners on how to mitigate future damages.
