## **Top Ten Rule Violations**

- 1. What direction must you follow during green light time, when lakes are open to all boaters, on both lakes?
  - Counterclockwise
- 2. How many life jackets do you need on board for a boat with 8 people?
  - One per person plus one throwable device
- 3. What does the yellow light mean?
  - Lakes open for idle speed only
- 4. What is the max number of people you can pull behind the boat?
  - o Two (2)
- 5. What does the red light mean?
  - Lake closed to ALL boating
- 6. When do you use docking lights?
  - Docking lights should only be used for close-quarter maneuvering, for instance when docking a boat.
- 7. Is it a violation to sit in the front of a moving boat with the feet hanging over the front?
  - o Yes
- 8. When do you use the orange flag?
  - When a person is down in the water
- 9. How fast can you go in a No Wake zone?
  - Slow enough to not produce a wake
- 10. What happens if you receive (3) warning tickets issued within a 365-day period on the lakes?
  - o ALL of your boat decals may be revoked for up to ONE year
- If you see something life threatening, CALL 911.
- If you see a boater/swimmer committing a violation, call the non-emergency police phone number 812-988-6655 & tell them you need CSCD Officer to respond to a lake violation.
