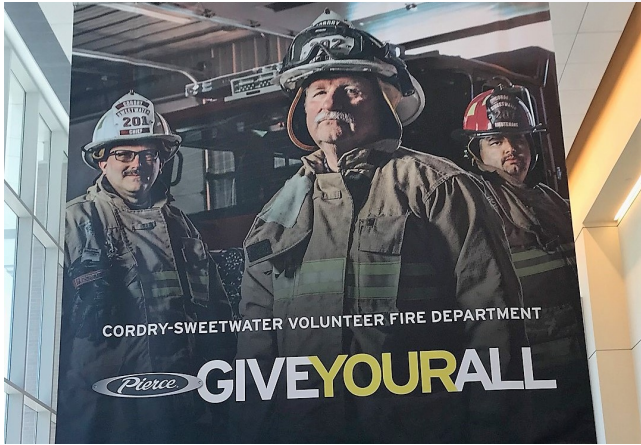

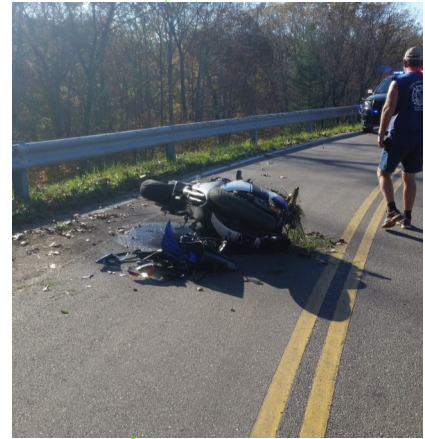
SHERIFF AND DEPUTIES AT CSLOA SOCIAL

RECENT THEFT IN CSCD

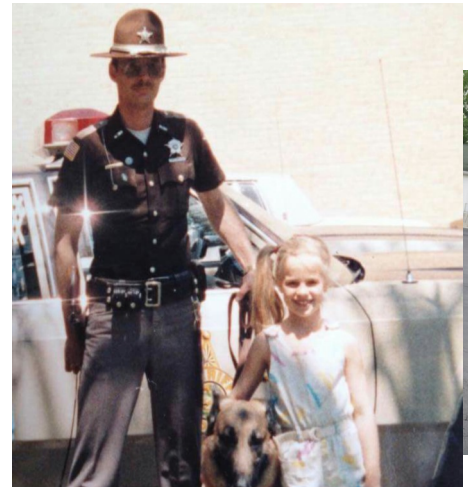
