

RESOLUTION NO. 2025- 9

RESOLUTION AMENDING A PORTION OF RESOLUTION NO. 2024-20

WHEREAS, the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District (“CSCD”) is an Indiana Conservancy District organized and operating pursuant to I.C. 14-33; and,

WHEREAS, I.C. 14-33-5-20(1) provides in part that the Board of Directors of CSCD shall exercise general supervision of and make regulations for the administration of the affairs of CSCD; and,

WHEREAS, CSCD maintains and operates two (2) large lakes known as Cordry Lake and Sweetwater Lake (“Lakes”) as a part of its works of improvement; and,

WHEREAS, CSCD allows freeholders to utilize the Lakes for recreational purposes and the operation of motorized and non-motorized watercraft thereon; and,

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2024, the Board of Directors of CSCD adopted Resolution No. 2024-20, which resolution created comprehensive rules governing freeholders’ use of the Lakes and other matters related thereto; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of CSCD now believes it is in the best interests of CSCD to amend a portion of Resolution No. 2024-20.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Cordry-Sweetwater Conservancy District that:

1. Paragraph 3 of Classification of Watercraft, Powered Watercraft, is hereby deleted in its entirety and in lieu thereof the following is inserted:

“3. Fishing Watercraft – no longer than 21 ft. with a maximum engine horsepower of 40hp. Fishing watercraft with engines greater than 40hp will be classified as a Power/Speed Watercraft. Watercraft purchased and continuously registered with CSCD before March 31, 1990, are considered fishing watercraft regardless of horsepower and are considered grandfathered watercraft and may receive renewal decals as allowed pursuant to the rules relating to grandfathered watercraft provided in Resolution No. 2024-20.”

2. Paragraph 10(c) of Required Decals and Lot Numbers is deleted in its entirety and in lieu thereof the following is inserted:

“(c) The watercraft’s decal has expired and more than forty-five (45) days have elapsed since the date of expiration. A grandfathered watercraft whose decal has expired may receive a renewal decal if a renewal decal is requested within forty-five (45) days of the date of the expiration of the current decal.”

3. All parts and provisions of Resolution No. 2024-20 not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.


