Potentially a timing issue between when meters are read vs actual usage. Reportedly in sync per changes in read times made last year.

Water Operator Report: Reviewed report provided by Josh Bryant. Most concerning is the sheer volume of leaks in zones followed by the indication that there are leaks on the "newer" main line on Nineveh Rd. Zones 11 & 13 appear to be our largest volume areas of loss. N. Johann to provide map of zones via ziptility.

Old Business: Goals for 2022 were further discussed:

1) Disaster Contingency Plan. – Discussion about having work session outside of board meeting to observe/walk through. (tentatively scheduled for June 9th After Board Meeting)

2) File for SWIF matching fund - Unfortunately they changed the criteria and subsequently we no longer qualify.
